



# Do You Have Marginalia?

## Goals:

*No need to worry! Marginalia is just any mark, doodle, or comment written in the margin of a book. Marginalia is what makes a book personal.* Encourage students to make books their own by commenting and reacting to texts with Glose for Education. Create a rich collaborative ebook with links to photos, videos and gifs alongside highlights, comments and reactions.

## Description:

Choose an ebook to develop into an enriched text. As students read, encourage them to react often with whatever comes to mind. Students can create comments that include links to videos, images and gifs to relate the passage to images that come to their minds. Students should also highlight, react and notate within the Glose for Education app.

**Appropriate for:** All students

**How to F:**

- ✓ Select a book for augmenting
- ✓ As the class reads through the book they should react often to what they are reading with:
  - a. Links to videos, images and gifs
  - b. Highlights
  - c. Reactions
  - d. Notes
- ✓ Students should also react to the comments posted by their classmates.
- ✓ Periodically, examine as a class the way the book is being enriched.

<b>Extend</b>	<b>Support</b>	<b>Connect</b>
Divide the class into two groups and select different books for each. Have the students create marginalia for each book and then swap books so that students can react to the additions made by the other group.	Use marginalia to help provide background knowledge and explanations for students who may struggle with the text. Use images to help students with vocabulary and add unfamiliar words to the dictionary.	Choose a book with a corresponding movie. Have students react to the text with images and short clips from the movie. Prompt students to comment about whether the movie accurately portrayed the book.
