



Viral Reading



Goals:

What does this quote mean to you? Help students identify quotes and ideas from their reading that are worth sharing with the larger community. Develop student's ability to relate quotes to personal experience and ideas by sharing quotes they find especially meaningful.



Description:

In their reading, students will use the Glose for Education app to highlight quotes that resonate. By highlighting and commenting on their quote, it will appear on the book's quote page.. Students will then write or print their quote to have in a visible spot. Encourage students to share their favorite quotes on social media platforms.

How to Glose:

- Students select a favorite quote from their reading and highlight it. This will automatically add their favorite to the classroom's quote page.
- Students react and notate as to why they chose this passage as their favorite quote.
- Students write or type their quote to keep it somewhere visible.
- Students share their quote on their favorite social media platform.

Extend	Support	Connect
Have students create an art project about their quote. In addition to visually representing the quote, students can use pictures and drawings to illustrate the significance.	Talk with students to help them think about what kind of idea they want to convey and then work together to find a quote that embodies that sentiment.	Engage in a classroom discussion on why particular quotes were chosen and what they mean in the context of the book and to the person who selected it.
